Basic Information about health plan coverage through the Cement Masons Health and Welfare Trust Fund for Northern California:

- Employees working under a collective bargaining agreement with the District Council of Plasterers and Cement Masons of Northern California (the Union) which require contributions to be made to the Trust Fund **are covered once they meet the eligibility requirements.**
- Eligible Dependents:
 - Lawful spouse
 - Children to the age of 26:
 - Natural born children
 - Stepchildren
 - Adopted Children
 - Foster Children
 - Children older than 26 if they are prevented from earning a living because of mental or physical handicap so long as the disabled child was eligible as a dependent when he/she turned age 26.
- Plans offered through the Cement Masons and Welfare Trust Fund meet “minimum value” as defined by ACA—certified Plan’s consultant.
